The Transitional Intentional Interim Ministry Training Seminar (TIIMS) is a rigorous three-phase event spanning approximately six months. United Methodist TIIMSA-credentialed and UMEA approved Lead Trainers (LT) provide the Seminar leadership.

Phase I is a four-day training event designed to:

- sharpen one's general ministry skills,
- provide new insights for working as a change agent during transitional needs,
- introduce tools and techniques for use in short-term leadership, and
- orient one towards "intentional interim" ministry.*

Phase II is the opportunity for Seminar participants to employ Phase I concepts and strategies, which continues with LT mentoring for each Seminar participant in their ministry setting.

Phase III is a two to three day on-site event which integrates TIIMS theory and practice using the Change Process Reports prepared during Phase II as case studies. Upon completion of this seminar, the participant will earn Certification as a Transitional Intentional Interim Ministry Specialist. Application for national Approval status through the United Methodist Endorsing Agency of the GBHEM will be available to participants who receive TIIMS Certification and have at least one year in pastoral experience.
