

**Transitional Intentional Interim Ministry Training Seminar (TIIMS)

Description

The Transitional Intentional Interim Ministry Training Seminar (TIIMS), a three-phase event spanning four - six months, is led by a National Lead Trainer for Interim Ministry of the United Methodist Church.

Phase I is a virtual four-day training event designed to:

- *Sharpen one’s general ministry skills
- *Provide new insights for working as a change agent
- *Introduce tools and techniques for use in short-term leadership,
- *Orient one towards “transitional intentional” ministry
- *Includes the introduction of the “C.P.R.,” Intentional Interim Ministry Specialists “Change Process Report.”

Phase II continues for four to six months in one’s home church or extension ministry, during which time the insights learned in Phase I are practiced in a mentored relationship with the Seminar leader.

Phase III is a two day training event when theory and practice are more fully integrated using the Change Process Reports prepared during Phase II as case studies and the basic tools introduced in Phase I are reviewed for deeper understanding.

TIIMS or Seminar is the short-hand term for this entire three-phase experience—Transitional Intentional Interim Ministry Training Specialist.

A Seminar is made up of 1-2 leaders. The lead trainer(s) will work for four to six months with experienced, mature, productive clergy who are now making themselves available to help churches with special transitional congregational needs.
